The dignified Aggtelek Cup is probably the earliest, still running climbing competition in the world, held at the end of August, every year since 1973. The competition routes are on natural rock with additional artificial holds, at the World Heritage Site of Aggtelek, only open to climbing once a year for this competition! The Hungarian Mountaineering and Sport Climbing Federation hereby invites international competitors to participate in the event.

- male A,
- male B,
- female B.

After one qualifying route, the best will continue to the final, all climbing is on sight.

08:30 – Closing of the difficulty isolation for the categories B, female/male

09:00 – Qualifying round for the B, female/male

12:00 – Closing of the isolation for the categories A male

12:30 – Qualifying round for the cat. A male

17:30 – Stair running competition, "coke box climbing", slack-lineing, classical music in the world famous cave concert hall, slide-show, dance-party.

08:30 –Closing of the isolation

09:00 –Finals for the categories B, female/male

12:00 –Finals for the cat. A male
